METAL



- Aluminum Cans & Foil
- Tin, Steel & Metal Cans
- Aerosol Cans (*empty, no lids or tips*)
- Small Pieces of Scrap Metal

PLASTIC



- Plastic bottles, Jars, Tubs or other Plastics with Recycling Numbers 1-7 printed on them (*without lids or caps*)
- **No plastic bags of any type**

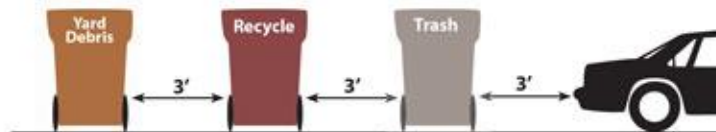


PLEASE REMEMBER:

Your Guide to Sustainable Waste Management



What We Recycle On-Site

1 Paper

Office documents, newspapers, magazines, and cardboard.

2 Metal

Aluminum, tin, small scrap metal.

3 Numbered Plastic (1-7)

Clean bottles, jugs, or tubs with numbers 1-7 printed on them.

4 E-Waste

Computers, phones, tablets, and other electronic items.

5 Fluorescent Bulbs

We accept up to 10 bulbs a week per customer.

6 Med-Waste

Sharps in sealed sharps containers (**drop-off only**)

7 Batteries

We accept all batteries at our office.

8 Cardboard

Flattened cardboard can be dropped off at our on-site dumpster.

How to Recycle Properly

Prepare Your Materials

• Clean and Dry

Ensure all items are clean and free of food residue or liquids. Dirty recyclables can contaminate the entire recycling bin, and will result in your bin not being serviced.

• Loose in the Bin

Make sure all recyclables are loose in your bin. We can not recycle plastic garbage bags.

• Remove Caps and Lids

• Flatten and Save Space

Make sure your bins are not overflowing or packed tight. This ensures that your bin will be serviced as scheduled.

• Label Awareness

Be mindful of recycling labels and numbers on plastic items. Only recycle numbers 1-7.

• When in Doubt, Throw it Out

If you are unsure whether an item can be recycled, it's better to throw it in the trash to avoid contaminating the recycling stream. You are always welcome to call our staff for any questions!

Recycling Schedules

Make sure you confirm your pick-up days and have your bins out the night before to avoid missing collections.

What You **Can't** Put In Your Recycling Bins

1 Hazardous Materials

- We can not accept hazardous wastes like chemicals, paints, or medical supplies. Please take directly to the landfill.

2 Pizza Boxes, Soiled Paper, Food or Liquid

3 Plastic Bags or Styrofoam

4 Glass or Fluorescents

- Recycle only on-site.

5 Lids, caps, or large pieces of scrap metal

6 Un-numbered Plastic, Caps, Lids, Hangers, or Plastic Clamshells

7 Bagged Recycling

- All recycling should be loose

8 No Tanglers

- Leave hoses, wires, chains, and electronics out of your recycling bin.

9 Glass or Fluorescents

- Recycle only on-site.
